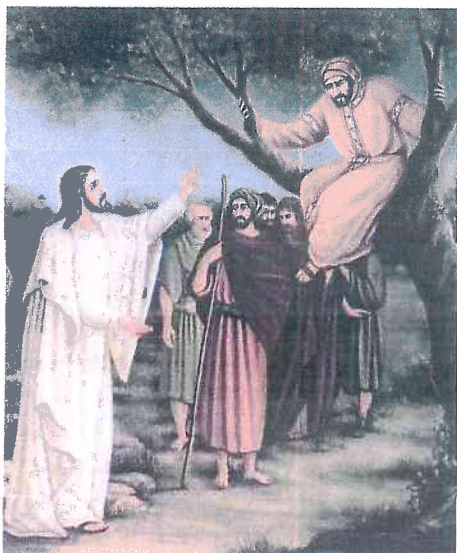

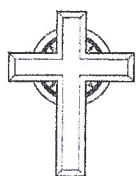

The Lochaber branch of Sense Scotland has been in touch. This is a charity that supports disabled people with communication needs. There are developments in Fort William and the charity is looking to recruit more caring, supportive and enthusiastic people to work as support workers in our area. Skills for the role include patience, supportiveness, attentiveness and the ability to empathise with others.

Full training is provided and the charity offers training opportunities to gain qualifications that can lead to further career development. There is a variety of shifts available, ranging from a couple of hours to full time. Sense Scotland is very flexible and happy to talk about the time people are able to offer. The hourly rate is £7.46 per hour, moving on to £8.25 from 1st October 2016.
