

Our Easter confessor this year is **Father Wynne**. He will be available for confession on Monday, between 7 p.m. and 8 p.m.


Our sincere thanks to all those who have volunteered to be readers during Holy Week. This is a very special ministry in the life of the parish.

As in previous years, special parish Easter candles are available for use during the Easter Vigil. These are to be taken home and used for special occasions.


The front door of the church was totally jammed on Saturday morning. Michael Kennedy worked much of the day making urgent repairs. We owe him a huge debt!



**Christ carries the Cross by James Tissot** 




The raising of the Cross by Rubens
